

# A Parent's Guide to Year 11 Checkpoint Reports

## Checkpoint Report 1

KS2 English: 5  
KS2 Mathematics: 5

A mix of KS2 data and CAT scores is used to help teaching staff set realistic but challenging targets. These can be amended upwards by staff based on performance. In this example, strong KS2 performance and above average CAT scores would produce high target grades.

CAT Scores:  
Verbal: 124  
Nonverbal: 120  
Quantitative: 116  
National average: 100

Attendance from 27-08-2015 to 14-09-2015: 100

Average attendance at the College is 97%. Students missing lessons are expected to catch up on checkpoint tasks

Tier Average is the score achieved on average for students in the same tier of entry, either higher (H) or Foundation (F) and allows comparisons with students following the same course.

Checkpoint % is typically based on 2-4 checkpoint tasks between cycles.

In Art the student is above average but slightly under target grade. Teacher has identified more focus on Prep as an issue.

In Geography student has achieved well above average score and in line with target. Teacher is pleased with both RFL and Prep.

In Mathematics, Student is performing in line with average but under target grade. Teacher had identified issues with both Prep and Routines for Learning (RFL). Student will need to address issues. It may be appropriate to contact the teacher for further discussion.
