KFYWORKERS

Each student with an EHCP has a keyworker. You will have received an email from the keyworker or a phone call and they will regularly meet with your child to discuss the support they are receiving and to encourage them to participate within College life and extracurricular opportunities. They are a key person for your child to turn to for support and also a point of contact for you as a parent or carer.

This year in response to the SEN Survey we will also be implementing keyworkers for our K Code students, we hope that this will allow for increased communication and a point of contact for you as a parent or carer alongside their tutor and class teachers.
