All sessions run by LTA accredited coaches, DBS checked and 1st aid trained. We provide all the equipment necessary to join in.

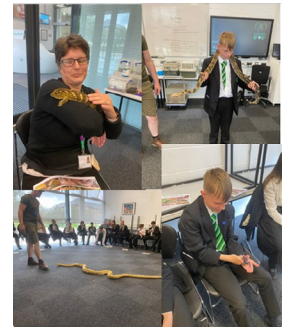
